

# Westfield Doncaster

### Project description

The redevelopment of Westfield Doncaster received planning approval in May 2004. Work on the \$650 million project commenced in January 2007, taking about 20 months to complete. The Centre will be a catalyst for future development on Doncaster Hill.

The Centre's transformation has increased total retail space to around 120,000 square metres, with approximately 420 stores. New retailers include David Jones, Big W and Target. Village Cinemas has reopened with a state-of-the-art multi-screen complex, including Gold Class cinemas and VMax screens.

New restaurants and a larger café court give diners over two levels sweeping views of the skyline towards the City. The revitalised Westfield Doncaster introduces a new era in retail sophistication in Australia and is the glittering centrepiece of commercial and retail activity in the heart of Doncaster Hill.

Westfield Doncaster offers a selection of leading local and international designer brands, a new David Jones, refurbished Myer, Coles and Safeway supermarkets, Target and Big W discount department stores and state-of-the-art Village Cinemas.

Car parking has increased from 3,480 spaces to 5,000 spaces.

### Official launch

Westfield Doncaster was officially opened by Victorian Premier, John Brumby and Westfield Group General Managing Director, Stephen Lowy, on 16 October 2008. The Doncaster complex is set to become Westfield's flagship centre in Victoria, joining premium centres at Bondi Junction in Sydney, Century City in Los Angeles, the San Francisco Centre and Westfield London.
